

Average Weather For Limon, Colorado, USA

Location

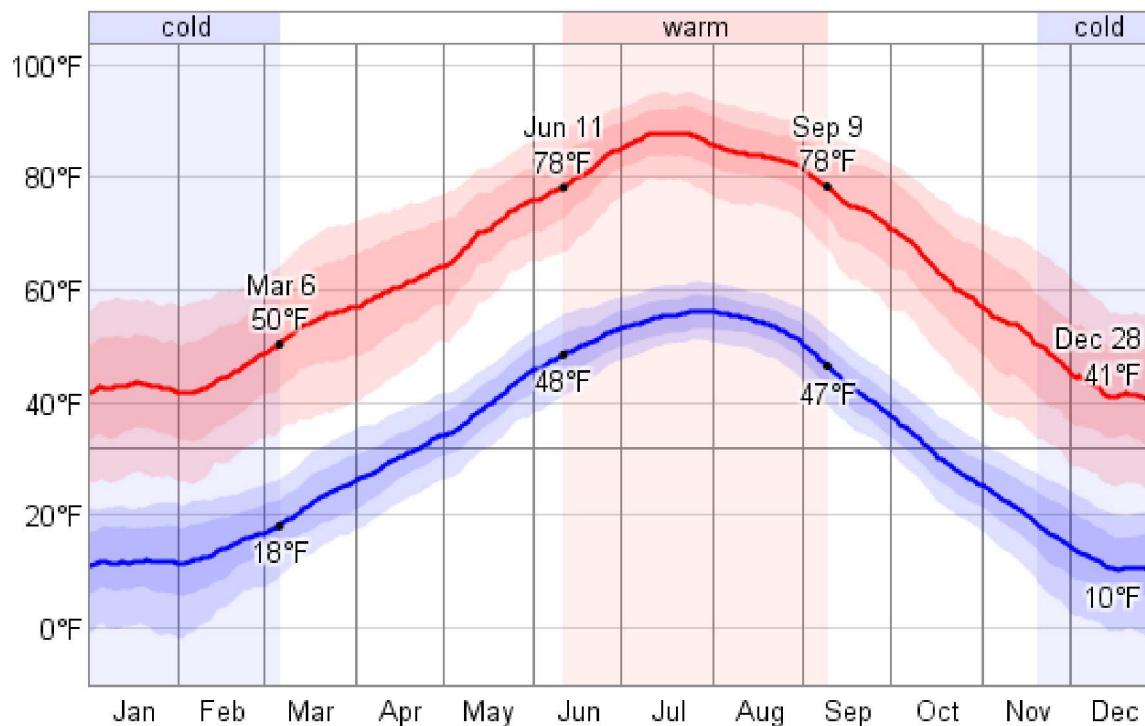
This report describes the typical weather at the Limon Municipal Airport (Limon, Colorado, United States) weather station over the course of an average year. It is based on the historical records from 1996 to 2012. Earlier records are either unavailable or unreliable.

Limon, Colorado has a cold semi-arid steppe climate. The area within 25 miles of this station is covered by *grasslands* (99%).

Temperature

Over the course of a year, the temperature typically varies from 10°F to 88°F and is rarely below -2°F or above 95°F.

Daily High and Low Temperature



The daily average low (blue) and high (red) temperature with percentile bands (inner band from 25th to 75th percentile, outer band from 10th to 90th percentile).

The *warm season* lasts from June 11 to September 9 with an average daily high temperature above 78°F. The hottest day of the year is July 17, with an average high of 88°F and low of 56°F.

The *cold season* lasts from November 20 to March 6 with an average daily high temperature below 50°F. The coldest day of the year is December 18, with an average low of 10°F and high of 41°F.
